9.	Description of training post	<p>This post is based in Edinburgh Dental Institute. The post gives the opportunity for assessment and treatment of new patients allowing the post holder to gain wide, well supported, experience.</p> <p>This involves six months based in the Oral surgery Department from September 2024 to March 2025. Oral Surgery gives the opportunity to perform a variety of surgical procedures, including extractions, biopsies, and treatment of more complex conditions under LA, sedation, and GA. In Restorative dentistry from March 2025 to September 2025, there will be the opportunity to diagnose and treat a wide variety of patients including periodontal, prosthodontic, and endodontic cases. Trainees may get an opportunity to be involved with the education of undergraduate Dental Hygienist-Therapists.</p>

13.	Educational programme summary	<p>There is a Scotland-wide education programme for Dental Core Trainees which is designed to match the DCT curriculum. The programme has four themes running through each year of Dental Core Training. These are: Clinical, Communication, Career Development Skills and Quality Improvement & Patient Safety. Posts begin with a local health board and NES induction, followed by face-to-face study events throughout the year, supported by Turas Learn. These events include all Dental Core Trainees in Scotland, as does the annual DCT conference.</p> <p>All trainees have access to study leave time (in line with terms and conditions of service) and budget. This is predominantly to fund attendance of DCTs at the compulsory NES Educational events, however funding may be available to contribute to the cost of other courses linked to an agreed PDP.</p> <p>DCT posts include time for self-directed learning and trainees are encouraged to use this time for personal study and to complete quality improvement projects.</p>
