

NHS Education for Scotland in collaboration with the Care Inspectorate produced the **Preventing Infection in Care** DVD.

A **trainer programme** was developed in 2016 to support the implementation of learning from the DVD and to build local capacity to deliver the education programme.

The programme provides an opportunity for care home staff with an **education remit** to enhance their knowledge and skills on infection prevention and control education and support them in implementing this into their local training provision.



The trainer programme covers:

- infection prevention and control education focussing on the Standard Infection Control Precautions which align with Scotland's National Infection Prevention and Control Manual
- specific infections in care homes and outbreak management
- application of learning activities in practice, audit/monitoring tools and impact evaluation
