TARLAND INFORMATION

- Tarland is a small rural village located in Royal Deeside Aberdeenshire- 6 miles from Aboyne.
- Population of Tarland approximately 800.
- We have a satellite GP surgery operating 5 half days per week in Tarland. The main surgery is located in Aboyne.
- There are many beautiful walks around Tarland and historical monuments on your doorstep i.e. Tomnaverie Standing Stones.
- It is well located for easy access to the Cairngorm Mountains, many castles (including Balmoral Castle), Crathie Church, The Lecht and Glenshee ski resorts
- Tarland has a 9 hole golf course, and many more courses nearby.
- Fishing available by arrangement on the River Dee. Trout fisheries nearby.
- There are mountain bike trails in Tarland - 'Tarland trails' and proposed structure of Tarland Trails 2.
- There are 3 hotels situated in Tarland
- There is a Camping and Caravanning site.

PHARMACY INFORMATION

- We are situated in the main square of Tarland.
- We dispense approximately 1400 items per month (mostly NHS prescriptions).
- We are small, very friendly and primarily patient focused.
- We provide other NHS services including minor ailments, Pharmacy First services including treatment for UTI and impetigo, Gluten Free Food service, Smoking Cessation. We fill MDS trays for approx 8 patients and provide MARS charts for patients receiving Care in the Community.
- Details of the team: We are a small team consisting of 1 regular pharmacist, 1 regular locum pharmacist and 2-part time trainee dispensers.

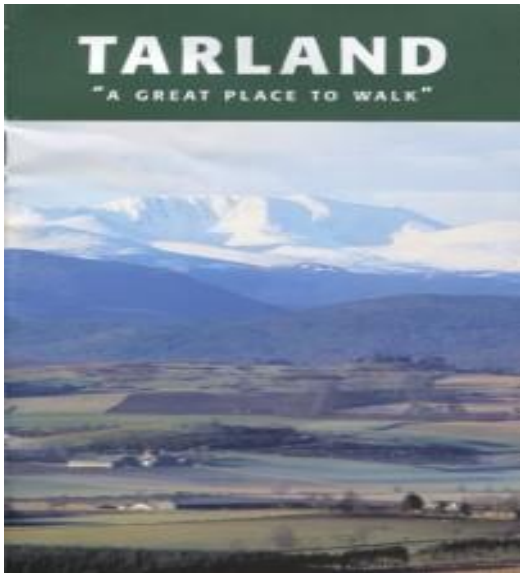

- The post on offer is under the NES Co-ordinated R&R/DtF Programme
- We offer ability to learn services offered in a Community Pharmacy and become both competent and confident to provide these when qualified. Be able to complete appropriate paperwork as required for payment of services. Work through NES training programme for a Pre-Registration Pharmacist and work towards passing exam.
- The tutor Kathleen is an Independent Prescriber with further qualifications in 'Clinical Examination Skills'. She has experience working in hospital, a community health drop in centre and community pharmacies
- The pre-registration student will be able to attend training opportunities offered by NHS Grampian or CPS locally.
