9.	<b>Description of training post</b>	<p>The DCT3 will be involved in Consultant led Quality Improvement and clinical sessions in Restorative Dentistry and Dental A&amp;E.</p> <p>The Quality Improvement sessions with NHS Education for Scotland's Dental Clinical Effectiveness Workstream [which includes Scottish Dental Clinical effectiveness programme (SDCEP) and Translation Research in a Dental setting (TRiADS)] will be integrated into the timetable to gain experience of and take forward topical Quality Improvement projects.</p> <p>The clinical sessions will involve sessions in Restorative Dentistry, both treatment and chairside teaching of UG students.</p> <p>In this post you will be able to exploit the links between Quality Improvement, research and clinical practice.</p>

13.	<b>Educational programme summary</b>	<p>There is a Scotland-wide education programme for Dental Core Trainees which is designed to match the DCT curriculum. The programme has four themes running through each year of Dental Core Training. These are: Clinical, Communication, Career Development Skills and Quality Improvement &amp; Patient Safety. Posts begin with a local health board and NES induction, followed by face-to-face study events throughout the year, supported by Turas Learn. These events include all Dental Core Trainees in Scotland, as does the annual DCT conference.</p> <p>All trainees have access to study leave time (in line with terms and conditions of service) and budget. This is predominantly to fund attendance of DCTs at the compulsory NES Educational events, however funding may be available to contribute to the cost of other courses linked to an agreed PDP.</p> <p>DCT posts include time for self-directed learning and trainees are encouraged to use this time for personal study and to complete quality improvement projects.</p>
