As a DCT1 you will have opportunities to gain experience in a range of Restorative clinics, Special Care Clinics and Oral surgery clinics as well as restorative student teaching and dental accident and emergency. In this DCT1 post, you will undertake a range of PDS duties from March 2025 to September 2025. These may include dental inspection of schools, domiciliary care, care of patients who have special needs or require special care, and paediatric









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		dentistry. There may also be opportunities to participate in GA lists. You will have the opportunity to receive training in inhalation sedation.

13.	Educational programme summary	There is a Scotland-wide education programme for Dental Core Trainees which is designed to match the DCT curriculum. The programme has four themes running through each year of Dental Core Training. These are: Clinical, Communication, Career Development Skills and Quality Improvement & Patient Safety. Posts begin with a local health board and NES induction, followed by face-to-face study events throughout the year, supported by Turas Learn. These events include all Dental Core Trainees in Scotland, as does the annual DCT conference. All trainees have access to study leave time (in line with terms and conditions of service) and budget. This is predominantly to fund attendance of DCTs at the compulsory NES Educational events, however funding may be available to contribute to the cost of other courses linked to an agreed PDP. DCT posts include time for self-directed learning and trainees are encouraged to use this time for personal study and to complete quality improvement projects.
