8.	<b>Description of the training post</b>	This post is for one year and is based in the Lothian Public Dental Service and the Edinburgh Dental Institute. Part of the week will be spent in the Restorative Department in EDI and the other part of the week is spent with the Special Care Dentistry Team within the Acute Hospital sites in NHS Lothian. The Special care component of the post gives the opportunity for assessment and treatment of the more medically complex patient, allowing the post holder to gain wide, well supported, experience. In Restorative dentistry, there will be the opportunity to diagnose and treat a wide variety of patients including periodontal, prosthodontic, and endodontic cases. Trainees may get an opportunity to be involved with the education of undergraduate Dental Hygienist-Therapists
9.	<b>Primary Care training element</b>	The Public Dental Service part of this post will be spent in Acute Hospitals in NHS Lothian, rather than Primary Care, however please note any applicant must be eligible for a provider number

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11 <b>Educational programme summary and library facilities</b>	There is a Scotland-wide education programme for Dental Core Trainees which is designed to match the DCT curriculum. The programme has four themes running through each year of Dental Core Training. These are: Clinical, Communication, Career Development Skills and Quality Improvement & Patient Safety. Posts begin with a local health board and NES induction, followed by face-to-face study events throughout the year, supported by Turas Learn. These events include all Dental Core Trainees in Scotland, as does the annual DCT conference. All trainees have access to study leave time (in line with terms and conditions of service) and budget. This is predominantly to fund attendance of DCTs at the compulsory NES Educational events, however funding may be available to contribute to the cost of other courses linked to an agreed PDP. DCT posts include time for self-directed learning and trainees are encouraged to use this time for personal study and to complete quality improvement projects.
