		Paediatric Dentistry and will also have scope for sessions within the Orthodontic
		Department. The post gives the opportunity for assessment and treatment of new
		patients allowing the post holder to gain wide, well-supported, experience. In
		Paediatric Dentistry, there will be the opportunity to treat a wide variety of patients,
		including dental trauma, using local anaesthesia, inhalational sedation and
		general anaesthetic. The Paediatric Dental Service runs clinics over several sites
		and some sessions will be away from EDI.

This is predominantly to fund attendance of DCTs at the compulsory NES Educational events, however funding may be available to contribute to the cost of other courses linked to an agreed PDP. DCT posts include time for self-directed learning and trainees are encouraged to use this time for personal study and to complete quality improvement projects.
