

Post-Registration Foundation Programme for Pharmacists



REGISTRATION Open 1st December 2025 - 12 midday on 16th January 2026

This programme:

- is aimed at pharmacists early in their career, who are in patient-focussed roles to encourage them to develop knowledge, skill, values and behaviours to confidently practice in community, hospital or primary care practice
- aligns to the RPS UK Post-Registration Foundation curriculum
- includes an independent prescribing (IP) course delivered by a Scottish university
- enables integration to the multidisciplinary team through the need to have collaborators from different professions review practice
- requires an Educational Supervisor to undertake regular meetings & review evidence.

WHY JOIN?

- Provides a structured training programme
- ✓ Proven to increase confidence & competence
- Includes an IP course
- Provides opportunities to experience a wide variety of practice and to receive feedback on your practice.

WHAT IS INVOLVED?

- The programme comprises of 5 domains
- Evidence is developed in the workplace using supervised learning events with other healthcare professionals feeding back on/observing your practice
- Online Educational Support sessions, clinical skills training, leadership Peer Thinking sets and face to face simulation sessions to enhance prescribing decisions
- Assessment of your portfolio by the RPS after which you will receive the credential of having completed the programme.

You need to:

- ✓ be qualified and on the GPhC register
- be employed & have agreement from your employer
- ✓ have an Educational Supervisor before registering
