connections with others



Bereavement Help Points

Bereavement Help Points
take the form of a free
monthly drop-in space for
anyone who has been
bereaved. A relaxed and
supportive group
environment for
conversations, peer
support and signposting

- Free of charge
- No previous connection to the hospice required
- No booking required
- Accessible

Collaboration

The Listening Lounge with Brandon Trust

Working together to provide a
space for adults with a
learning disability to explore
grief and loss. Each monthly
session has a craft activity to
compliment conversations.

Measure of Success

Listening Ear service started April 2020

- October 2024 - September 2025 - 340 referrals
- Total referrals since 2020: 565

Walk Talk Kernow started April 2022, walks in 4
areas across Cornwall

- October 2024 - September 2025 saw 561
walkers

Bereavement Help Points in 6 locations since
January 2023

- October 2024 - September 2025 saw 209
attendees

Listening Lounge started January 2025, session
numbers vary with a maximum of 8.

- 27 clients supported so far this year
