Workshop Descriptions

Workshop 1.A – Applications of AI in GP Training

During this workshop, you will explore the applications of Artificial Intelligence (AI) in GP training. There will be opportunities to consider the risks and benefits, and to gain some experience using AI in specific situations relating to GP training.

Workshop 1.B – Appreciative Inquiry

Appreciative Inquiry is a strengths-based approach to creating change. Rather than identify a problem and look at how to solve it, Appreciative Inquiry involves exploring what is already working and how to build on that. In this workshop, you will explore how this can be applied to clinical supervision and feedback in GP training.

Workshop 2 – Training Future GPs to Hold Risk

This workshop explores whether we are doing enough to train future GPs to hold risk. This will be considered by examining how we train registrars to hold risk through graduated exposure, and considering how we manage risk as Educational Supervisors.

Workshop 3.A – Empathy in GP Consultations

Empathy is an important part of GP consultations, and it is mentioned in the first paragraph of the RCGP curriculum. However – how much do we actively ‘teach’ the use of empathy in GP training? And how do you teach empathy anyway?! This workshop will explore the concept of empathy, how it applies to GP consultations, and how we can facilitate learning on this topic for our GP registrars.

Workshop 3.B – Arts and Medicine

In this workshop, you will be able to consider the value of using Art and Literature in GP education. You will have the opportunity to share ideas for how to inspire and motivate GP registrars using this approach.
