These may include dental inspection of schools, domiciliary care, care of patients who have special needs or require special care, and paediatric dentistry. There may also be opportunities to participate in GA lists. You will receive training in inhalation sedation. National Dental Inspection Programme and Childsmile activity may also be offered. Although Mastrick will be the clinic base, regular sessions will take place in other clinics in the city as well.  The part of the post based at ADH, ARI, RACH and Stracathro Hospital will commence in March 2025 through to August 2025. At ADH the DCT1 will be based |    |  |
|     |   | in the Restorative Dentistry Department and be involved in the care of patients with varying and complex treatment needs. The post will involve the trainee attending new patient consultation clinics, in addition to carrying out treatment clinics. The full range of procedures in Restorative Dentistry is carried out in a fully integrated manner. All aspects of Endodontics, Periodontics, Fixed and Removable Prosthodontics, including Maxillofacial Prosthodontics, and Implant Dentistry are performed. The DCT will also be involved with Oral Surgery/OMFS clinics and operating at ADH, ARI, RACH and Stracathro Hospital.   |    |  |

|     |   | to-face study events throughout the year, supported by Turas Learn. These events include all Dental Core Trainees in Scotland, as does the annual trainee conference.  All trainees have access to study leave time (in line with terms and conditions of service) and budget. This is predominantly to fund attendance of DCTs at the compulsory NES Educational events, however funding may be available to contribute to the cost of other courses linked to an agreed PDP.  DCT posts include time for self-directed learning and trainees are encouraged to use this time for personal study and to complete quality improvement projects.  All DCTs, who have not worked in an Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery (OMFS) unit in Scotland previously, attend an additional two-day induction course: Maxfacts. This course is designed to cover the essential skills for an OMFS DCT post and is delivered by OMFS consultants and senior trainees. The teaching is backed up by on-line resources which will made available to DCTs prior to the Maxfacts course. |
