8.	Description of the training post	The GDH part of the post will commence in September 2022 through to March 2023. This placement is ideally suited to anyone interested in Orthodontics or Paediatric Dentistry. The Orthodontic department offers a wide range of orthodontic experience including consultant supervised treatment/review sessions, new patient clinics and Emergency clinics. Opportunities are available to attend a variety of joint clinics in orthognathic surgery, paediatrics, cleft care and restorative dentistry to give as wide an exposure as possible to the range of orthodontic treatment carried out within the hospital. The Paediatric Department in GDH offers clinical activities including: new patient clinics; treatment sessions; inhalation sedation; accident and emergency; trauma clinic; and paediatric oral medicine. Clinical time will also be spent within the Royal Hospital for Children (RHC) where DCTs are involved in the in-/ out-patient care of medically compromised children including those with oncology, haematology and cardiac diagnoses, treatment clinics and new patient assessment of medically complex children. The DCT1 will undertake a range of PDS duties from March 2023 to August 2023. This part of the post may

Primary Care training element Educational programme summary and library facilities	 include dental inspection of schools, domiciliary care, care of patients who have additional needs or require special care, and paediatric dentistry. There will also be opportunities to receive training in inhalation sedation and may be opportunities to participate in GA lists. In this post the DCT1 will work for six months in the PDS. You therefore need to be eligible for an NHS list number. There is a Scotland-wide education programme for DCT1s which is designed to match the DCT curriculum. The programme will include an induction followed by a number of study events throughout the year, supported by Turas Learn. These events will be delivered with a mix of face to face and online sessions, which will include all DCT1s training in Scotland, as does the annual trainee conference which includes the DCT2s and DCT3s. In addition, there will be an education programme for DCT1s during their time in the Public Dental Service which has been designed to support this role. All trainees have access to study leave time (in line with terms and conditions of service) and budget. This may be used to access MFDS/MFD/MJDF courses and other courses linked to an agreed PDP. DCT1 posts include time for self-directed learning and trainees are encouraged to use this time for personal study and to complete quality improvement projects.
