8.	<b>Description of the training post</b>	This post is based in Edinburgh Dental Institute. This involves six months based in the Restorative Dentistry Department from September 2025 to March 2026. The post gives the opportunity for assessment and treatment of new patients allowing the post holder to gain wide, well supported, experience. In Restorative dentistry, there will be the opportunity to diagnose and treat a wide variety of patients including periodontal, prosthodontic, and endodontic cases. Trainees may get an opportunity to be involved with the education of undergraduate Dental Hygienist-Therapists. Then there will be six months based in the Oral Surgery Department from March 2026 to September 2026. Oral Surgery gives the post holder the opportunity to see and treat the full remit of Oral Surgery. There will be opportunity to assess and perform a variety of out-patient surgical procedures, including surgical extractions, third molar surgery, biopsies, and treatment of more complex conditions under local anaesthetic and sedation, well supported by our specialist and consultant Oral Surgeons. The post holder will also have the opportunity to attend Oral Surgery general anaesthetic theatre lists for both adult and paediatrics. A well established governance structure will give opportunity for improvement activity and portfolio development.

11.	<b>Educational programme</b>	There is a Scotland-wide education programme for Dental Core Trainees which is

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<p><b>summary and library facilities</b></p>	<p>designed to match the DCT curriculum. The programme has four themes running through each year of Dental Core Training. These are: Clinical, Communication, Career Development Skills and Quality Improvement &amp; Patient Safety. Posts begin with a local health board and NES induction, followed by face-to-face study events throughout the year, supported by Turas Learn. These events include all Dental Core Trainees in Scotland, as does the annual DCT conference. All trainees have access to study leave time (in line with terms and conditions of service) and budget. This is predominantly to fund attendance of DCTs at the compulsory NES Educational events, however funding may be available to contribute to the cost of other courses linked to an agreed PDP. DCT posts include time for self-directed learning and trainees are encouraged to use this time for personal study and to complete quality improvement projects.</p>
