3.	<b>Rotational Post information</b>	<p>Rotational</p> <p>September 2022– March 2023 - Hunter Health Centre, East Kilbride: Public Dental Service (PDS, also referred to as the Community Dental Service).</p> <p>March 2023 – August 2023 – Glasgow Dental Hospital, Glasgow: Oral Surgery.</p>
4.	<b>Training unit/location/s</b>	This post is based within both NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde and NHS Lanarkshire Health Boards. Six months is based at the Hunter Health Centre PDS, East Kilbride then six months at Glasgow Dental Hospital (GDH)

6.	<b>Travelling commitment</b>	There will be a requirement to travel within NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde and NHS Lanarkshire Board area in order to obtain a range of experience.

8.	<b>Description of the training post</b>	<p>The DCT1 will undertake a range of PDS duties from September 2022 to March 2023. The PDS element may include dental inspection of schools, domiciliary care, care of patients who have additional needs or require special care, and paediatric dentistry. There will also be opportunities to receive training in inhalation sedation and may be opportunities to participate in GA lists.</p> <p>The second part of the post at GDH will commence in March 2023 through to August 2023. The Oral Surgery department at Glasgow Dental Hospital and School offers a broad range of clinical activities and experience the following; consultant clinics, treatment area, minor Oral surgery sessions, supervision of BDS students, sedation sessions, treatment and theatre lists at non base hospital sites. There is a regular Oral Surgery journal club, at which DCTs are expected to present, to benefit from appraisal by senior staff.</p>
9.	<b>Primary Care training element</b>	In this post the DCT1 will work for six months in the PDS. You therefore need to be eligible for an NHS list number.
10.	<b>Educational programme summary and library facilities</b>	There is a Scotland-wide education programme for DCT1s which is designed to match the DCT curriculum. The programme will include an induction followed by a number of study events throughout the year, supported by Turas Learn. These events will be delivered with a mix of face to

		<p>face and online sessions, which will include all DCT1s training in Scotland, as does the annual trainee conference which includes the DCT2s and DCT3s. In addition, there will be an education programme for DCT1s during their time in the Public Dental Service which has been designed to support this role.</p> <p>All trainees have access to study leave time (in line with terms and conditions of service) and budget. This may be used to access MFDS/MFD/MJDF courses and other courses linked to an agreed PDP. DCT1 posts include time for self-directed learning and trainees are encouraged to use this time for personal study and to complete quality improvement projects.</p>
